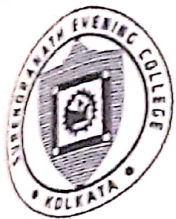

1. What is the meaning of transition?

a change from one state or condition to another

2. What was din-i-ilahi?

Din-i-Ilahi was a religious idea created by Mughal Emperor Akbar in 16th century a mix of different religions including Hinduism, Islam, Christianity, Jainism, and Zoroastrianism.

3. Who was Aurangzeb?

Ans-4 = Higher costs: Ceiling murals can be costly due to design and professional installation fees.

4. Downfall of mural empowerment?

Ans: 3 → Aurangzeb was the sixth ruler of the Mughal empire who ruled over the entire Indian subcontinent for 49 years. He was an orthodox religious Sunni Muslim ruler and was a very good administrator. He compiled the Fatawa-e-Alamgiri and established Sharia law and Islamic economics throughout the Indian subcontinent.

5. Who was Robert Clive?

Robert Clive, 1st Baron Clive, KB, FRS, also known as Clive of India, was the first British governor of the Bengal Presidency. Clive has been widely credited for laying the foundation of the British East India Company rule in Bengal.

6. Who was Mirza Jafar?

Mirza Jafar, was a commander-in-chief or military general who reigned as the first dependent Nawab of Bengal of the British East India Company.

7. When did the Battle of Plassey occur?

The Battle of Plassey was fought in northeastern India on 23 June 1757.

8. Who was Siraj-ud-Daulah?

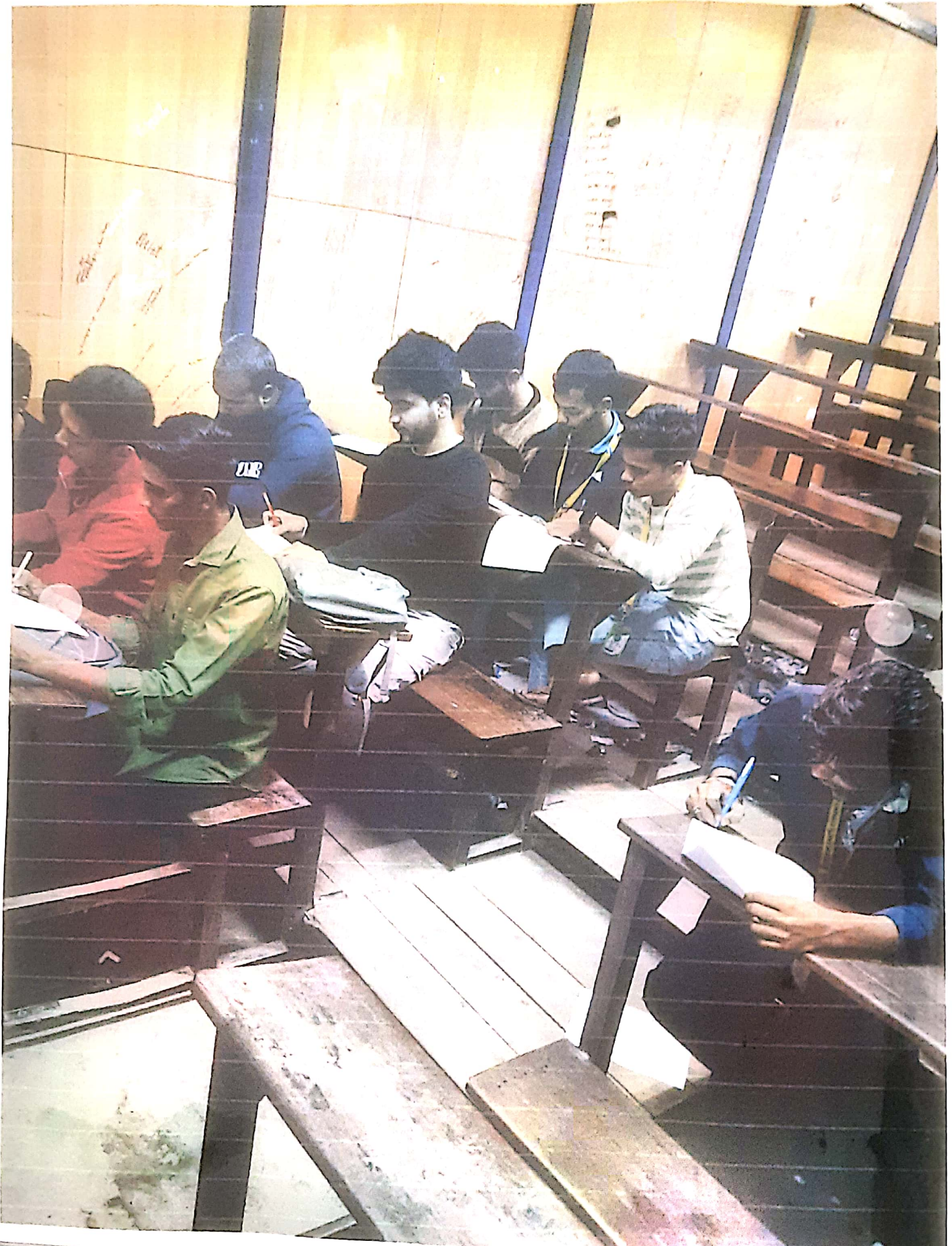
Mir Syed Ali Khan Mirza Muhammad Siraj-ud-Daulah commonly known as Siraj-ud-Daulah or Siraj ud-Daula, was the last independent Nawab of Bengal. The end of his reign marked the start of the rule of the East India Company.

9. Who was Raja Ram Mohan Roy?

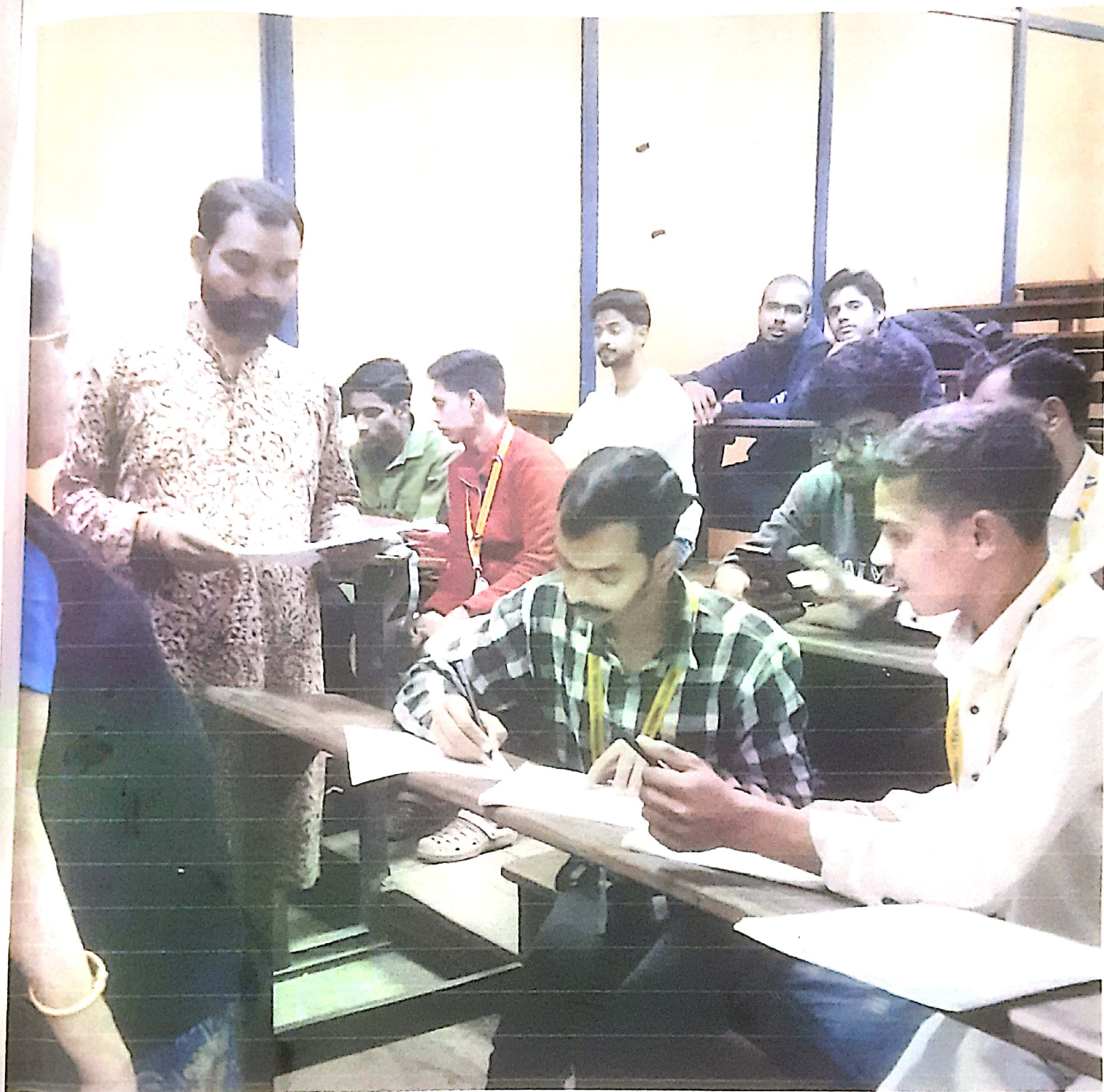
